




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## New Stipulations

Employed

Save 30% of income during stay

Housing Action Plan

 Guests must be available for one-on-one case management at least once a week

 Every two weeks the action plan is reviewed and updated to ensure the family or individual is making progress

Families are required to seek housing weekly

 All guests are required to follow through with referred services such as:

- Mental health counseling
- Substance use disorder (SUD) services
- Veterans assistance
- Parent Support
- Dept. of Social and Health Services (DSHS) requirements
- Domestic Violence (DV) or Citizens against Domestic Violence (CADA) advocate
- Dept. of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) requirements
